

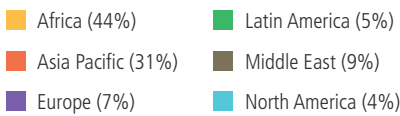

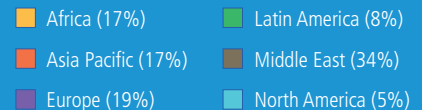

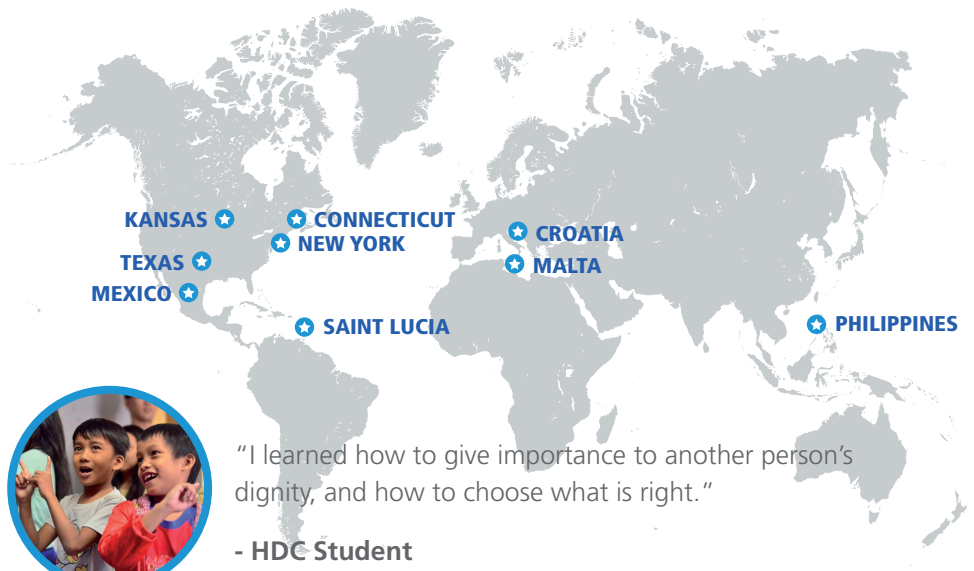

WYA continues to develop its Human Dignity Curriculum (HDC), a program that focuses on personal development and informed decisions related to students' sexuality based on an understanding of themselves, and in respect of their own human dignity and the dignity of others.
